Are you looking for a way to connect with other moms and dads in the neighborhood? Well, look no further than Ravensworth Mom and Dads’ Playgroup.

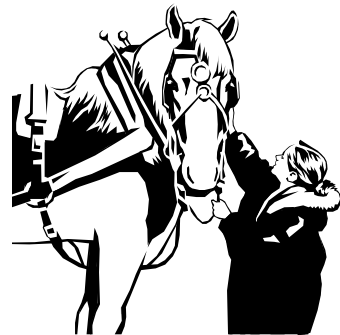
