We now have a wonderful new volunteer to head up the New Neighbors Committee formerly run by Jill Mowbray. Pam Ryan is our new lead and we're all very excited to see her. Welcome Pam!

The board made progress with the speeding problem in the community. At our last General Meeting, I shared the results of the traffic studies. We asked Supervisor Cook's office to request FDOT to look at Queensberry, Ellet, Moultrie, and Inverchapel. Of those four, only Inverchapel and Queensberry qualified for traffic calming measures. Of the realistic options available to us, the community voted in favor of adding an additional \$200 fine (on top of what the driver will get for speeding) for anyone caught speeding on Inverchapel and Queensberry. Some of you may already have seen the signs. The signs are not yet up on Inverchapel but are forthcoming. The county and VDOT are currently processing the request but I don't have an ETA. We on the board take this problem very seriously and I hope this helps improve the situation. The most ridiculous part of the problem is the people who speed live in or around our neighborhood. It's generally not coming from outside.

As with everything in life, nothing remains the same and I'm sad to say we lost a few of our board members last year. Some are moving and others have new adventures taking them elsewhere. It's been a lot of fun working with them and we're all appreciative of them donating their time and energy to helping keep Ravensworth Farm such as wonderful place to call home. This means we have new opportunities opening up for those who have always wondered about what goes on in RF and makes it tick. There's no formal commitment and you can donate as much or as little time as you'd like. If you're interested just shoot any one of us an email. Our emails are in the front of The Farmer and on the website. Mine is prez@ravensworthfarm.org and I'd be happy to answer any questions you have. The positions that are opening up are 1st VP and Corresponding Secretary. I'm pleased to announce we have a new 2nd VP, Scott Houghton. We're really excited to meet Scott and he's a great addition to the RFCA board. Welcome Scott!

On a related note, this will be my last year as President. My wife and I have a little one on the way (due July) and it's our first so my time will be even more limited. I'm taking a lesser role on the board but will definitely remain active in the community in a lesser capacity. I'll still represent us on the Braddock Road Citizens Task force (Supervisor Cook's Braddock Road Project steering committee) and continue to be a block captain. Two important issues we'll discuss at the next General Meeting will be a slight increase in dues in 2017 to offset the rising costs for the directory and Farmer. We focused especially on types of plants to support caterpillar needs (host plants) as well as attracting butterflies for their food (nectar sources). Did you know that in recent years the monarch butterfly population has been reduced by 90%? Yikes! What can you do to help these beautiful pollinators? Plant some annual flowers in your yard in the spring. Annuals come back every year! Also, plant milkweed! That's the only thing that monarch caterpillars eat. There are two local nurseries that sell milkweed: Nature by Design, and Earth Sangha.

VEHICLES & PARKING

If they are parked improperly, don't work or block the street, cars, trucks and other vehicles can be a neighborhood eyesore or even a safety hazard. Contact the Department of Code Compliance if you have a complaint about these parking or vehicle issues.

Parking Is Not Allowed

Some of the distances within which you can't park may surprise you. Measure it out sometime on your street. You'll be surprised at how far within that zone you and your neighbors routinely park. No parking is allowed:

- within 10 feet of driveways
- within 15 feet of fire hydrants
- within 30 feet of a stop sign
- within 20 feet of an intersection
- within 60 feet on the approach side and 10 on the departure side of a bus stop
- within 20 feet of a designated crosswalk
- facing against the direction of travel for that side of the road

Vehicles Parked on Lawn

Cars, trailers, and other vehicles may not be parked on the front yard of a home — but they may be parked in the rear or side yard. Gravel, pavers, or mulch added alongside a paved driveway are considered driveway, not parking in the yard.

Commercial Vehicles

Commercial vehicles may not park on residential streets, including:

- Tractor-trailers
- Semi-trailers
- Cement-mixers
- Garbage trucks
- Construction equipment
- Trucks, trailers or semi-trailers for transporting lawn-care equipment or storing or selling food.

Exceptions to this rule— one licensed taxicab or limousine per home may park on the street. Commercial vehicles also may park on the street temporarily while performing work or service. Vehicles commonly perceived as commercial — such as U-Haul trucks and trailers or vans used by a plumber or an electrician — may be parked on the street.

Construction Equipment

Construction equipment may be kept anywhere on the property if there is a valid building permit and work is in progress.

Inoperable Vehicles

Cars, trucks or vehicles that do not work may only be kept on a residential lot if they are within a fully enclosed building or structure, or are kept completely screened or shielded from view in accordance with Chapter 110 of the Code. An inoperable vehicle is defined as one that:

- Does not start and move under its own power; or
- Does not display valid license plates; or
- Does not display a valid inspection decal or one that has been expired for more than 60 days.

For complaints about junk or inoperable vehicles on private property, contact the following departments: Five or less vehicles: Police Department Traffic Division Impound Section, 703-280-0716 and Six or more vehicles: Department of Code Compliance, 703-324-1300.

Vehicles Blocking the Street

Parking is allowed on both sides of narrow residential streets, but vehicles must be parked close to the curb and face the proper direction of travel. However, it is prohibited to park in a line fire lane, within 15 feet of a fire hydrant, within 20 feet of a crosswalk and within 30 feet of a stop sign.

For complaints, call the Police Department non-emergency phone number 703-691-2131 and the police will investigate.






