ENERGY CONSERVATION IN RAVENSWORTH

The Green Service Center, GSC.

Why energy conservation?

- Wasting energy is throwing away money. --- Why should we do that? Sometimes it happens without our knowing, and certainly gives no pleasure.
- In hindsight, you could have been \$1000-5000 richer now, if you had started to save energy 10 years ago.
- Energy is becoming scarcer, and more people on this planet need more of it. So the prices are going up. No
 doubt about that.
- Be ahead of the crowd, be prepared and begin saving energy in your home.

Goal

In the long run we achieve a "**Green Community**", and become less dependent on oil, electricity and gas. As the price of electricity goes up, we can also demand better service from our suppliers, with fewer power outages.

Step-by-step.

Step 1. Start at Home with the easy things:

- Switch off the lights when you leave the room, or do it automatically.
- Replace the lamps with Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFL) or LED. Individual homes may save 10-20 percent on their electric bills this way. The CFL bulbs cost a bit more than the normal bulbs but they last 5 to 8 times longer, so there is your first savings. Moreover, the average CFL saves you \$20 to \$40 over its lifetime.
- Lower the thermostat of the heating at night, and raise the cooling thermostat at night a few degrees. This might save you up to 10 percent on both the electric bill in summer and the gas bill in winter.
- Don't cut down your trees. Their shade saves you 30 % on your air conditioning costs.
- Take the walk-through audit (cost only \$35) from the Green Service Center. We analyze your energy bills from the past 12 months, and look at your potential savings in the house. In a short report, we show you ways to save energy in your home. If you follow our advice, you can recoup the audit cost on your very next energy bill, and continue to save on the next bills.
- **Step 2. Detailed energy advice**: With the saved money of Step 1 you can pay for a **detailed energy audit** with advice on investments in better wall and roof insulation and windows (saves heating and cooling), a better furnace or air-conditioner. These long-term home improvements may save 20-30 % of your energy bills. Dominion Power and Washington Gas can help a bit with the initial costs. We can show you the way.
- **Step 3. Join the Ravensworth Green Service Center**: The Green Service Center is a non-profit entity, under the Green Committee of the Ravensworth Farm Civic Association, Inc. We give advice and counseling to every member of the Ravensworth community on how to save energy.

The **Green Service Center** can also lead you on the way to get your part of government support for energy conservation investments. The Green Service Center demonstrates and keeps a small stock of the most commonly needed low-mercury CFLs, the most advanced LED lamps and solar hats with fan.

We need enthusiastic volunteers to expand the **Green Service Center**. Please contact 703-321-4919 if you are interested in joining the Ravensworth Green Service Center. We will provide the training when you need it.

I am retired after doing several nation-wide energy conservation programs in developing countries for the last 15 years. We (my wife Lisa and I) moved to Ravensworth Farm about a year ago. Here, I want to show the Ravensworth community the path that we have shown so many communities elsewhere, to live in a more sustainable way by wasting less energy and money.

On the right hand side under **subjects**, select **building permit**. On the next page go to the third paragraph and select the **FIDO** link. The under building plans view by address and all the active permits for this address will appear by date.

Here's how to report housing and neighborhood problems: On the right hand side under subjects, select building permits. Then, on the next page go to step 3 and select code enforcement. The following page allows you to report all kinds of problems.

FCPL GOES GREEN!

The Fairfax County Public Library system just opened its first "green" branch library in September. Using sustainable building practices, local resources plus efficient energy and water systems, the Oakton Library is the first library building in the county to meet the criteria of the Leadership Energy and Environment Design (LEED) program, sponsored by the U.S. Green Building Council. Other buildings in the local area meeting this standard are the Fairfax Center and Crosspointe Fire Stations. The Burke Center Library, expected to be completed in summer 2008, will also be registered as a LEED-certified building.

WINTER GARDENING TIPS

- Soak soil around broad-leaf evergreens, conifers and bulbs before ground freezes. This is especially important because of the drought conditions experienced this summer.
- Make sure roots of plants you care about are mulched before deep freezing occurs.
- Don't forget our feathered friends: Provide food for wildlife with native plants that offer acorns, berries and seeds.
- Provide additional cover for wildlife by starting a compost pile of needles from pinecones and wreaths from your holiday decorations.
- Clean and fill your birdbath on a regular basis. Consider installing a heater if the temperatures go below freezing.



INFORMACION IMPORTANTE DE NUESTROS DESAGUES DE TORMENTAS

Los desagües de tormentas no son basureros! Cada vez que llueve, escombros y desperdicios se van por los desagües. Además, todo lo que usted ponga en los desagües se va directamente a los riachuelos locales.

Pasos para mantener limpio nuestros drenajes:

- 1) Bote la basura en los basureros. Recoja la basura enfrente de su casa y póngala fuera del alcance de los desagües.
- 2) Evite usar demasiado fertilizantes, pesticidas o herbicidas; también evite usarlos antes de una tormenta.
- 3) Lleve el aceite usado de motor y el anticongelante a la gasolinera más cercana. Nunca tire pinturas o limpiadores en el drenaje! Es contra la ley! Llame a la línea de información de desperdicios peligrosos al 703-324-5068 por si tiene preguntas de desperdicios de pinturas y limpiadores.
- 4) Tire los desperdicios de sus animales domésticos al inodoro, entiérrelos o póngalos en la basura.
- 5) Evite lavar carros en la casa, lavar aceite, gasolina o detergentes que se van al drenaje.

폭우가 흐르게 되는 하수구에 대한 중대한 공고

폭우가 흐르게 되는 하수구는 쓰레기 통이 아닙니다!

비가 올 때마다 온갖 잡 부스러기와 쓰레기가 이 큰 하수구로 쓸려 내려갑니다. 그뿐 아니라 여러분이 버리는 온갖 쓰레기들이 바로 그 지역의 강이나 시내로 흘러 들 어갑니다.

하수구를 깨끗하게 지키는 방법:

- 1) 찌꺼기는 쓰레기 통에 버리십시요. 길에 버려진 쓰레기는 주워서 쓰레기통에 버리시고 하수구 주변을 깨끗이 합시다.
- 2) 과다한 비료, 살충제 혹은 제초제의 사용을 피하시고 특히 폭우가 오기 전의 사용을 금합니다.
- 3) 여러분 주위의 주유소에서 사용하고 난 기름이나 부동액의 처리를 잘 하십시요. 절대로 가정에서 사용한 페인트나 페인트 지우는 액을 하수구에다 버리지 마십시요. 이것은 법에 저촉이 됩니다.

- 5) 집에서 차를 씻음으로써 기름이나, 가스, 세척제가 하수구로 흘러 들어가게 하지 마십시요.


