From our littlest three- and four-year old swimmers to our high school seniors, everyone had a great time this season. We look forward to an even better season next summer.

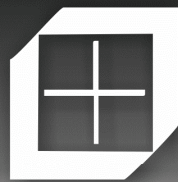


RAVENSWORTH SCHOOL (RE)CONSTRUCTION

RAVENSWORTH ELEMENTARY'S "NO SALES" FUNDRAISING

Have you noticed that the neighbor kids are not knocking on your door selling magazines or giftwrap? The PTA board of Ravensworth Elementary School committed to no sales-based fundraising since the 2012/2013 school year. All funds to support PTA initiatives for the school are obtained through donations. Many companies have programs that donate to schools based on products and services that parents and supporters of the school already use. You can support your neighborhood school by signing up for these program on the fundraising tab of the PTA website www.ravensworthpta.org.

Last year \$2,329.30 was donated to Ravensworth Elementary by the Box Tops for Education program. Earn 10 cents by clipping Box Tops from products and depositing them in the collection box in the school lobby, giving them to a student, or mailing them Attn: Boxtops to Ravensworth Elementary School - 5411 Nutting.

Last year Target's Take Charge of Education program donated \$859.17 to Ravensworth Elementary. Target gives 1% of purchases made with your Target Red Card back to the school. Redcard holders can sign up through the PTA website or by calling Target Redcard services at 1-800-316-6142. The ID for Ravensworth Elementary is 103696.

Ravensworth Elementary School registered as an Amazon associate. When purchasing items from Amazon, use the link for Amazon found in the fundraising section of the Ravensworth PTA website and Amazon will give 4% of your purchases back to the school. Last year Amazon donated \$730 to Ravensworth Elementary.

Last year Safeway's Escrip program donated \$605 to Ravensworth Elementary. You can link your Safeway card to the school through the PTA website or by calling Limari Perez at 571-594-0507. The school ID is 6629193.

Last year Giant's A+s program donated \$1,641.78 to Ravensworth Elementary. You can link your Giant Card to the school through the PTA website or by calling Limari Perez at 571-594-0507. The Ravensworth ID for this program is 02081.

Ravensworth's largest fundraiser earned \$16,500 last year. The Laps 4 Learning event has students walk or run laps to earn money for the school. Students collect tax deductible donations for each lap they complete.

PARKING INFORMATION



Fairfax County's parking rules are few in residential neighborhoods. However, keep in mind that it is not legal anywhere...

- ...to park within 10 feet of driveways (yours or someone else's).
- ...to park within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- ...to park within 30 feet of a stop sign or within 20 feet of an intersection or crosswalk.
- ...to park on the wrong (facing traffic) side of a street.
- ...to park within 60 feet of the approach side and 10 feet of the departure side of a bus stop.

It is a zoning violation to park vehicles on lawns for more than 48 hrs. Generally, only 30% of the front lawn can be paved or otherwise made into a driveway in R3-R4 zoned areas. Ravensworth Farm is R3. It appears that concrete, asphalt, pavers, gravel, and heavy mulch all cause lawn to be considered driveway.

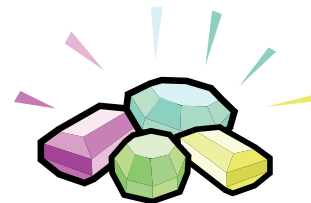

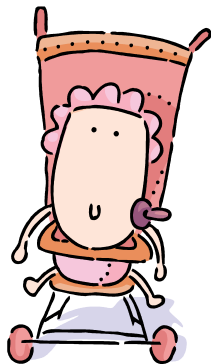

November 5 is Election Day but October 15 is your last day to register to vote in that election. See fairfaxcounty.gov/elections for details. Our precinct is Ravensworth (115) and our polling location is Ravensworth Elementary School. School will be closed November 4 and 5. Statewide, you can vote for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and Attorney General. Fairfax County has a special election for Sheriff and a School Bond Referendum. Ravensworth Farm's District 39 for the Virginia House of Delegates has a contested election. The Virginia State Senate is not up for election this year.

SUGARY SIPS COULD LEAD TO DEPRESSION

When you're feeling down, often the first instinct is to reach for something sweet to soothe the pain. Eating too much sugar is likely to lead to weight gain and sipping too much could also lead to a health problem that's not quite as visible. A new study presented at a conference of the American Academy of Neurology found that drinking too many sweetened drinks could lead to higher risk for depression. And both sugary and artificial sweeteners seem to be linked to the problem.

The study of more than 200,000 people revealed that those who guzzled more than four servings of diet soda a day suffered a 30 percent higher risk of depression than those who abstained from the stuff. People who sipped regular soda saw just a 22 percent increased risk.

Curiously, drinking coffee was linked with a 10 percent lessened risk of depression. Scientists say more research is needed, but the study adds to a growing body of science that says artificially sweetened beverages contribute to a slew of health problems in addition to depression.

Depression can be caused by a multitude of demons, from a chemical imbalance in the brain to plain old genetics. Women are in fact twice as likely as men to suffer from depression, perhaps due to hormonal changes and imbalances. Older people, such as those in the study, are also at a higher risk. Stress, trauma, certain medications and health conditions can also trigger despair.

Some symptoms of depression include trouble sleeping, chest pains, chronic fatigue, achy joints, changes in appetite and irritability. If any of the above sound like you — and you're craving sweets — don't be ashamed to see a doctor. It's important to know that depression is not your fault. With proper care, it can be treated.
